### Session 1

**Duration:** 1.5 hours

**Key features:** This session will consist of Creative presentations by care leavers on the different domains of the Declaration (care leavers who have been part of the process to develop the declaration)

- The session includes background information about the process involved to develop the declaration wherein care leavers from 25 different countries came together virtually after deliberations on the gaps and recommendations developed their own Declaration and received endorsements from networks and Civil Society Organisations.
- It will creatively travel the globe to show how the declaration is a product of international co-operation between care leavers
- The session will include suggestions from care leavers on taking the Declaration forward at local, national and international level and identifying areas where they need support from practioners, CSOs and policy makers.
- The responses of policy makers and other stakeholders will be invited after the presentation
