

## International Care Leavers' Convention 2020

### Main-event: Day 3 | Nov. 25, 2020

### Plenary Session: Good Practices on Supporting Care Leavers: Global, Regional and National Commitments

**Objective:** To share and learn from some of the existing on ground practices on leaving care and be informed by what Care Leavers think a good practice must be like.

**Format:** This panel discussion has two rounds

Round 1 brings speakers to showcase existing good practices by civil society organizations and service providers that support transition readiness and independent living. The panel discussion consists of presentations from different countries and sharing by practitioners such that other countries can learn from them.

Round 2 presents the opinion of Care Leavers in terms of what they want a good practice on aftercare to be like and share what are the essential components that make a “good practice” on leaving care. This interface between service providers and the target population helps bring a deeper understanding of how to work for the betterment of Care Leavers in ways that support them.

### Plenary 1: Policy and Legal Framework on Care Leaving: Overview, Concepts and Strategies

**Objective:** To sum up the key recommendations made during the convention proceeding and chart a roadmap going forward

**Format:** This session brings all the lead Care Leavers who have been anchoring the session together with the organizing committee members to present the key outcomes of the Convention that have emerged from the discourse over the three days. The roadmap of action that is solution-focused will be presented.

Key sector experts representing global experience then respond to the presentation sharing their thoughts, ideas and commitment to support the strengthening of the charter and offering ideas that can sustain the global connections of Care Leavers in future.

The session then ends with a formal vote of thanks.
